

## OUR WISH GRANTING VOLUNTEER TEAM “WISH LIST”



*Wish Granting volunteer teams play a vital role in helping us fulfill our mission to grant wishes for children with life-threatening illnesses.*

This unique role involves a commitment to training, project and time management, strong communications, problem solving skills and the ability to work with diverse groups of people. It requires some travel, and often, a greater time commitment than other volunteer roles.

Briefly described, granting a wish consists of approximately four visits with a family (three prior to the wish, and one follow-up), along with some time requirements throughout the wish granting process.

Wish Granting Volunteer Teams consist of: *one Wish Grantor* and *one Wish Companion* who volunteer together; meeting with wish children and their families and completing the steps involved in granting children's wishes.
